- Approved a joint ministry venture with Charrette Baptist Church, partnering to lead the Good News Club at Marthasville Elementary on Thursdays after school. This will be a great way to connect with young people at the Elementary School, help them understand and grow in the faith. - Approved the dry-walling of the west side of the lobby (previously brick) to give the lobby a more finished look.
- Set date for the Special Congregational Meeting (10/3) for the purpose of approving the use of funds for roof replacement on the Youth House. Date was also set for the October 24 Congregational meeting to elect council and cemetery board members. Both meetings will begin at 10am.

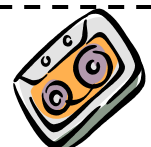

Paul's UCC?

Chances are, you know someone who is a
victim of domestic violence:
In the United States:

A woman is battered every 9 seconds
**More than 3.3 million children are exposed to domestic
violence each year.**
**One out of every five couples experiences domestic
violence.**

***ALIVE's mission is to provide counseling, emergency
sanctuary and other critical services to adults and chil-
dren impacted by domestic abuse, as well as to in-
crease awareness in order to create a supportive com-
munity. ALIVE's vision is to end domestic abuse, re-
storing safety and peace one family at a time.***

Alive's Statistics

During Fiscal Year 2009/10 ALIVE provided services to
1,138 adults and 610 children by:
-answering 24,489 crisis calls.
-furnishing emergency shelter for 296 victims of domestic
violence and 428 children, totaling 3,389 "Nights of Safety."
-assisting 345 clients with 507 court actions.
-providing 3/832 hours of individual adult counseling ser-
vices to 463 clients.
-providing 1,134 hours of children's services to 335 children
and parents.
-facilitating 114 support groups with 59 individuals in attend-
ance.

ALIVE also educated the community through more than 90
presentations to more than 1,730 individuals.

Volunteers provided more than 18,804 hours of service to
ALIVE clients and programs, averaging more than 1,500
hours per month.

Calling All Those Interested In Creative Arts!

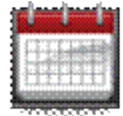
